“Pomen mikroMOOC tečajev, razvitih v okviru STEM-CPD@EUni projekta, za vseživljenjsko učenje pedagoškega kadra STEM fakultet” (= Importance of microMOOC courses, developed in the frame of STEM-CPD@EUni project, for continuous professional development of pedagogical personnel at STEM faculties)

The event has taken place on Thursday, 26th of January 2023, 10:00 - 13:00 at the University of Maribor, Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, Koroška cesta 160, SI-2000 Maribor, Slovenia.

In the frame of the second lecture, more technical aspects regarding development and production of microMOOC courses were presented as well as possible options for hosting them were discussed.
