Introducing the STEM-CPD Ambassadors

At the last STEM-CPD@EUni Summer School (University of Naples Federico II, from 2-7 October 2022), 15 lecturers from 7 countries became CPD Ambassadors who are committed to professional development in teaching and learning at their own institutions. They each developed their own use case, which aims to support fellow lecturers in improving the quality of education. In this newsletter, we present Tina Skalar and her STEM-CPD use case.



Who are you?

Dr. Tina Skalar, Assistant Professor at the University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Chemistry and Chemical Technology How does the User Case that you have created at the Summer School help you and your fellow lecturers now at your university?

I chose the topic of my user case, Organizing an industrial process tour in live, because I saw that this type of teaching is more experiential for students and would be more likely to be chosen by professors if they had a roadmap to help them organise the entire event. The content ranges from organisational issues to active student participation and assessment of the event. My colleagues were pleasantly surprised by the content because I had raised a topic that would bring innovative learning approaches to the way we study. During the discussion and also during the two field trips to two different plants, I received new suggestions for improvement from their side as well. At the same time, the evaluation with my colleagues helped me to do my own brainstorming where new ideas emerged.

Would you recommend others to attend the STEM-CPD@EUni Summer school?

Of course, yes. Because doing a user case means a structured brainstorming of ideas on a specific topic.
