ECTN Elections for 2023-2026 term

At the 2023 ECTN General Assembly in Amsterdam on 14-15 April there will be **elections for President-Elect, two members of the Administrative Council, and a member of the Quality Standards in Teaching Committee.** *Nominations for these important positions are invited from all members of ECTN.* The nomination procedure and the election rules will be sent to all members in the next days. When you receive these documents, please distribute them widely within your institution. Any member of the ECTN association can be nominated for these positions and *the deadline for nominations is ten (10) days before the day of the General Assembly.*

The President-Elect will be a member of the Administrative Council for one year, acting as Vice-President and then become the ECTN President for the following three years followed by a period of two years as Vice-President.

Members of the Administrative Council are elected for a period of three years after which they can be re-elected for one more three-year period.


Please consider applying for one of these positions. They will provide you with the opportunity to contribute further to the activities of ECTN and play a role in the future activities of our association.

Program highlights
